Tuesday 20th June – Pizzica dance show

Pizzica is a popular Italian folk dance, originally from the Salento peninsula and later spreading throughout all the Puglia and Calabria regions and eastern Basilicata. The traditional pizzica is danced while embracing a partner. This hug need not necessarily involve two individuals of opposite sexes, and often two women can be seen dancing together.

Wednesday 21st June – Canoe excursion to the Alimini Lakes

The Alimini Lakes are a natural paradise, unique in Salento, for flora and fauna lovers. During navigation, you immerse yourself in an uncontaminated and unique world; In this context is the nature that speaks. Between the singing of birds and inebriating scents of the rich vegetation here you can admire the beautiful creeks that surround the lake and the beaches that are absolutely unattainable from the ground.

Thursday 22nd June – Guided visit of Zinzulusa Caves

Just few kilometers north of Castro, there are the Zinzulusa Caves, the most famous karst cave along the Apulian coastline and considered to be one of the most important examples in Italy. The name comes from the word zinzuli, meaning rags. In fact the extensive collection of stalactites and stalagmites that fill this cave look like rags hanging from the ceiling.
